Monthly Meeting

April 12, 2021

Town Officials Present: Chairman Richard Ferfecki, Supervisors James Przybylski and Greg Van Asten, Treasurer Lisa Matuszak and Clerk Connie Przybylski

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice: Chairman Ferfecki called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call resulted in all town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Friday, April 9, 2021. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes: *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on March 8, 2021 and the special town meetings on March 12, 2021 and March 19, 2021.*

Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report: The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of March 31, 2021 of \$13,431.37 in the Premier Checking Account, \$349,841.30 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$629,686.48 in the Huntington National Bank Investment Insured Cash Sweep Account. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

Correspondence & Clerk's Report: Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) a concern about the slide at the Krakow park and the need for more chips by swings (2) noise complaint from Mr. Hager about ATV riding for long periods and riding on the embankment of Main Street (3) eight fire incidents reports from the Pulaski Tri County Fire department (4) four land use permits, two for single family dwellings, one for agriculture structure, and one for an accessory residential structure (5) withdrawal order from Managed forest Law on Town Line Road (6) fire inspection report for the Angelica Town Hall (7) a letter from the Department of Safety and Professional services (8) letter for the Wisconsin Department of Transportation about moving up road work on Highway 32 from South Chase Road to County E will start mid to late June (9) school district of Bonduel minutes and agendas for March and April. Clerk Przybylski also presented the board with the spring election results, and a report from the Department of Justice and the Department Homeland Security stating that there was no evidence of any foreign government interference in the 2020 federal elections.

Reports from Town Officers: Supervisor Przybylski Road Maintenance filled potholes on Green Valley Road, Cuba, West Deer, Middle Drive, Beech Drive, Carroll Road, Hillside Drive, Elm Road, and Town Line Road. Brought a concern to Chairman Ferfecki about low shoulder on Carroll Road and low shoulder at the intersection of Green Valley/Town Line Road; also culvert is ran over at same intersection. Supervisor Przybylski Supervisory report (1) issued four culvert permits; two on Mile Drive; one on Elm Road; one on West Deer, who has to replace a plastic culvert not to town ordinance requirements (2) sent a letter to a property owner for not installing culvert ends (3) attended three zoom meeting one with Governor Evers on the state budget, one for hail and weather variables and how to mitigate risk, and one with NATAT (National Association of Towns and Townships) about the American Rescue Plan and the amount of money the Town may receive and what it can be used for.

Supervisor Van Asten reported (1) received a complaint about ATV noise and speeding in Krakow (2) ordered volleyball nets for Krakow Park (3) received a call about a home buyer wanting two horses in the hamlet of Krakow (4) checked picnic tables for the Krakow Park and bathrooms will be open in May.

Report from Town Planning Commission Chairman/County Board Supervisor ~ District 11 and Town Chairman: Town road limits will be off starting today, April 12. Working with Shawano County, Robert E Lee Associates, and contractor with the grading and pitch of the roads in Krakow for the storm sewer. The light at Krakow One Stop gas station will need to have a shield installed or they will be liable for any accidents caused by the light shining toward traffic on Highway 32. Citations were issued for not abiding by road weight limits. Crack sealing will be done on some town roads with money left over from snowplowing budget. Received call about setbacks and having animals on property. On a two acre parcel of land you are allowed one and a quarter animal units. NEW Rescue has assets and liabilities of \$35,855.17. Seventy percent were transports and thirty percent were no transports. Seventy-five percent were emergency calls and fifteen percent non-emergency. Angelica has 9 runs with a total of 99 runs for the month. Response time was 1.23 minutes for January and 7.39 minutes for February. Most of the runs go to St. Mary's and Bellin Hospitals. No Tri-County Fire Department meeting this last month. Shawano County voted 24 to 3 in favor of the second amendment. All County Roads will be open for ATV use, unless posted. Executive committee will be interviewing for the vacant Corporate Counsel position. American Rescue Plan will be allocating money to Towns and County and is based on population with half of money given this year and second payment next year.

Public Comments: Sally and Tony Steffen had questions about blacktopping Hill Road and when it will be done. Ron Banaszynski brought up a hole in the gravel on Green Valley Road. James Mills asked about burning weeds in the ditch on his property.
