**April 21, 2026 (Rescheduled from April 13)**

**Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice:** Chairperson Maroszek called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call resulted in all the town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Wednesday, April 15, 2026. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

**Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes:** *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on March 9, 2026*

**Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report:** The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of March 31, 2026, of \$22,514.98 in the Premier Checking Account, \$512,678.35 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$547,889.18 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$19,216.74 in the Fox Community Credit CD, \$367.30 in the CoVantage Angelica Community Park Donations Account, \$2,561.37 in the CoVantage ATC Savings Account, and \$5 in the Fox Community Credit Member Share Account. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

**Correspondence & Clerk's Report:** Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) two land use permits, two for an accessory residential structure (2) fifteen fire incident reports (3) Bonduel EMS report for March. Clerk Przybylski reported that she attended Board of Review training on March 30, received a call for a tree down in the Hillside Cemetery and Josh Kaczmarowski is cleaning it up, and gave the board the election results from the April 7 Spring Election with a total of 406 voters coming out to vote.

**Reports from Town Officers:** Supervisor Van Asten (1) installed six fire numbers (2) picked up posts from Shawano County (3) the town board worked together on the flooding issues. Supervisor Eckberg (1) issued a driveway/culvert permit (2) gave a list to the Pulaski Fire Dept and NEW Rescue with the roads that were closed due to flooding (3) gave a report from the tire pickup with Maple Grove.

**Town Chairperson:** Chairperson Maroszek reported that Grant Bystol called about what bridges needed to be closed due to flooding. With the ice storm there were a couple trees that came down, and with snowstorm Elsa, everyone helped.

**Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11:** James Przybylski thanked all the District 11 residents that took the time to vote for him, he appreciates your support. The Shawano County Highway Department sent out an invitation to town, village, and county board officials for their annual meeting which will be held on April 29, 2026, at 6 p.m. at the highway department at 3035 E. Richmond Street in Shawano. James Przybylski reported the master plan moved forward with the county board approving the \$121,000,000 for the new courthouse and jail pod which is the next step for improving safety, function and logistics which in the long run will help save money for our future generations. The next step will be

the design stage. Nick Mau sent out some good reading with Health Department news updates and he has copies on the back table if anyone is interested in taking one home. James Przybylski reported that the County Veterans affairs service has a new officer, Zachary Nuehlsdorf, he will be the lead on helping veterans with their needs. **Public Comments:** Ron Banaczynski reported that there is a sign down on Church Drive, the stop sign needs to be replaced on the north side of Deer/Maple intersection due to fading. Ralph Janiak asked when the board was going to pick up the barricade on Cuba and Green Valley, and the 40-ton bridge sign should be closer to the intersection of Elm/Nichols intersection. Gary Drzewiecki talked about the board serving and the authority of the town residents at the annual meeting.
