

TOWN OF ANGELICA  
**Special Town Board Meeting – April 7, 2022**

Those officials attending were Town Supervisors James Przybylski and Greg Van Asten, and Clerk Connie Przybylski. Others in attendance were Susan Pomprowitz, Brian & Cheryl Haskell, Brian Eckberg & Lana, Roger Neumann, Bryan Kolodziej, Terri Ferfecki, Richard Kucksdorf, Josh & Heather Kolodziej, Tom & Paula Maroszek, Joe Albers, Tina & Paul Marenger, Pat Karcz, Robert & Eileen Ripley, Patrick Derpinghaus, Ronald Banaszynski, Albert Payne, Wilbert Lewis, and Elmer Kraning.

The special town meeting was called to order by Supervisor James Przybylski, who acted as chairman of the meeting, at 6:30 p.m. at the Town of Angelica town hall for the purpose of appointing a qualified elector of the town to the vacant position of Town Chairman caused by the death of Chairman Richard Ferfecki.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the chairman of the meeting verified with the Clerk that proper noticing of the meeting has been done. The Clerk posted a meeting notice on Wednesday, March 13, 2022 at the town hall, posted on the town’s website and e-mailed to the Shawano Leader. In addition, an ad appeared in the Friday, March 25, 2022 issue of the Shawano Leader.

Five letters of Declaration of Interest from Brian Haskell, Brian Eckberg, Richard Kucksdorf, Elmer Kraning, and Tom Maroszek were opened and reviewed by the supervisors and the clerk. The Board invited the applicants to come forward and state their qualifications for being appointed as town chairman. All five applicants did this in the order that their applications were received. There were questions and discussion between the appointing board and the five applicants.

A motion was made by Greg Van Asten that Tom Maroszek be appointed to fill the vacancy for Town Board Chairman for the remainder of the unexpired term, which would be until April 18, 2023. The motion was not seconded. A motion was made by James Przybylski that Richard Kucksdorf be appointed to fill the vacancy for Town Board Chairperson for the remainder of the unexpired term, which would be until April 18, 2023, the motion was seconded by Greg Van Asten. The results of the call for votes were Greg Van Asten – yes, James Przybylski – yes and Connie Przybylski – yes. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by James Przybylski and seconded by Greg Van Asten to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried and the special meeting was closed at 7:21 p.m.
