

# TOWN OF ANGELICA

## Monthly Meeting

August 12, 2024

Town Officials Present: Chairperson James Przybylski, Supervisors Brian Eckberg and Greg Van Asten, Treasurer Lisa Matuszak, and Clerk Connie Przybylski

**Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice:** Chairperson Przybylski called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. There was a moment of silence for the safety of election workers for the job they do keeping our elections running smoothly and for the passing of Barbara McKeefry. Roll call resulted in all town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Monday, August 5, 2024. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

**Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes:** *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on July 8, 2024.*

**Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report:** The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of July 31, 2024, of \$70,015.70 in the Premier Checking Account, \$425,594.36 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$521,559.96 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$14,732.57 in the Fox Community Credit CD, \$363.11 in the CoVantage Angelica Community Park Donations Account, \$4,262.91 in the CoVantage ATC Savings Account, and \$5 in the Fox Community Credit Member Share Account. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

**Correspondence & Clerk's Report:** Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) nine land use permits, one for a waste storage closure, one for a storage shed addition, one for an agricultural accessory structure, one for an agricultural structure, one for a single family dwelling, two for an accessory residential structure, one for a nonresidential structure, and one for filling and grading (2) notice of sheriff sale (3) notice of transfer of franchise for Charter (4) preliminary estimate of population for town of Angelica of 1862 (5) Bonduel EMS monthly report for July.

**Reports from Town Officers:** Supervisor Van Asten reported that about the ARIP grants that are available. Chair Przybylski said the board discussed this at the March meeting. Supervisor Eckberg reported that he sat on Cedar Road and Middle Drive for four hours.

**Town Chairman:** Chairperson Przybylski reported that he and Josh Kaczmarowski did some tree and brush cutting on west Hillside Drive and Josh Kaczmarowski has also been patching holes on the roads. Doug Opolka added speed limit and dead-end signs at Cherry Drive. Chair Przybylski reported that Carl Gierke of Challenge the Outdoors at N2647 Cherry Drive called to let the town know to spread the word they will be having an open house on August 18. Everyone is invited to check out their facilities, there will be food, refreshments, fishing and tours. Chair Przybylski reported that the trees and brush were cleaned from the right of way on Church Drive by Complete Services, and they did a great job. Middle Drive and White Ridge Circle have been repaved and shouldering is done. The County just needs to cut the rumble strips leading up to the intersection of Green Valley Road and Middle Drive. Also, Apple Road has been shouldered. Chair Przybylski reported that he spoke to Jeremy Meyer at N2607 County C about his yard light. Jeremy placed a deflector on the top of the light housing so it's not so bright for oncoming traffic.

Chair Przybylski reported that the lock on the pavilion door was replaced, and the weeds were sprayed at the Angelica Community Park in Krakow. The crack sealing on Green Valley Road, Mile Drive, and Townline Road has been completed. Chair Przybylski reported that he picked up a recliner in the ditch on Green Valley Road between Middle Drive and Town Hall Drive. Chair Przybylski reported that he attended the East Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission Meeting at the courthouse in Shawano for a presentation of what they can offer to towns. The next scheduled ditch mowing will be late September or early October.

**Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11:** James Przybylski reported that the first meeting for the Ad Hoc Committee for the courthouse and jail renovations or rebuild should meet this month. If you have any suggestions that you would like to contribute just let me know and I can get them passed along.

**Public Comments:** Doug Opolka asked about the timeline of the Middle Drive Bridge project and when Shawano County will be wedge patch will be done on County Road C. Gray Drzewiecki asked about spraying ditches and there is a couch on West Town Road.

**Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session:**

- a. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the variance permit V-1-24 for John Slotten at N3867 Cedar Road for a setback of 735’ from the centerline of Cedar Road. John Slotten requests a variance so he can convert an existing hunting/fishing shelter into a single-family dwelling. John originally constructed the shelter in 2008 and built it out of the floodplain.
- b. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve returning the 2% fire dues to the Pulaski Tri County Fire Department in the amount of \$8,199.68.
- c. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to appoint Doug Opolka as member of the Town of Angelica Planning Commission.
- d. Chair Przybylski gave a report on the upcoming road paving schedule for 2025. They include Elm Road from Highway 160 to Deer Drive, Julius Street and Tony Streets in Krakow, and the replacement of the bridge on Main Street in Zachow. Chair Przybylski reported that the culverts on Tony Street may be replaced this year budget permitting, adding a cul-de-sac at the end of Julius Street. Chair Przybylski also reported about spraying trees/brush in the ditches using Complete Services on the areas where the trees/brush were cleaned from the ditches and right-of-way.

**Specific Town Board Notice and Agenda for Upcoming Town Board Meeting:** Hillside CD, Class B Roads, furnace replacement at the town hall. The next town board meeting will be held on Monday, September 9, 2024.

**Voucher Listing/Payment of Bills:** *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve Vouchers V-10707 through V-10739 for a total of \$84,047.66.

**Adjournment:** *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 7:23 p.m.
