Monthly Meeting

August 8, 2022

Town Officials Present: Chairperson Richard Kucksdorf, Supervisors James Przybylski and Greg Van Asten, Treasurer Lisa Matuszak, and Clerk Connie Przybylski

Town Officials Absent: None

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice: Chairperson Kucksdorf called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call resulted in all town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Wednesday, August 3, 2022. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes: *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on July 11, 2022 and the Board of Review held on July 28, 2022.*

Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report: The Treasurer's report was read by Clerk Przybylski showing balances as of July 31, 2022 of \$209,665.64 in the Premier Checking Account, \$365,031.31 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$532,967.38 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$13,788.52 in the CoVantage Savings/Cemetery Account. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

Correspondence & Clerk's Report: Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) Laboratory report for the Krakow Park showing no bacteria in the water (2) nine fire incident reports from the Pulaski Tri County Fire department (3) two land use permits, one for a single family dwelling, and one for an accessory residential structure (4) one Wisconsin uniform dwelling permit (5) letter from Shawano County Health department on instructions for Monkey pox (6) Letter from the City of Shawano landfill about increasing the tipping fees on garbage and recyclables.

Reports from Town Officers: Supervisor Przybylski Road Maintenance filled potholes on east Hillside Drive. Cut brush/weeds in Zachow on Main Street at bridge. Cut down three trees on Hill Drive. Supervisor Przybylski supervisor report (1) Town has six used culverts to sell from Deer Drive which sell for \$5/ft. (2) gave suggestions to Chairperson for next year's road paving budget; section of Green Valley Road from Middle Drive going north; Hillside Drive from County F going east; east Hillside Drive from County C to termini; and Cherry Road (3) talked to Grant Bystol about specifications on polyethylene culverts (4) received a call from a resident about bird droppings on the inside entrance of Krakow Post Office. Talked to postmaster and she said they are adding deterrents to stop birds from perching above the doorway (5) received a call from a resident who asked about an update on cleanup of Krueger garage in Zachow

Supervisor Van Asten (1) Carroll Road sign missing (2) Nichols Drive guard rail is bent on the south side (3) will be installing a fire number on Carroll Road (4) will be doing another water test for the Krakow Park.

Town Chairman: Chairperson Kucksdorf contacted Keith Chambers, Pulaski village President, about the annexation of property for EF-7 Enterprises and Chambers said it is on the August Agenda. Talked to Matt Zierden about the end walls on Deer Drive and Shawano county uses end walls; so all culverts were installed with end walls. Matt Zierden also stated that Melvin took all excess dirt from the Deer Drive project; only a ¼ mile away. Met with Robert Jackovich regarding his driveway project. Chairperson Kucksdorf also took a look at Lake Sandia Drive by Schmechel driveway; Matt Zierden stated it would be an estimate of two hours to open it up and see what is going on under blacktop.

Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11: James Przybylski reported that Richard Ferdecki's family donated a bench that will be set at the Human Services Building in his memory. District 23 David Gilane is leaving the County Board and moving out of the district. Paul Pionke is the new veteran service officer appointed July 27, 2022. Shawano County entered into a statewide mutual aid compact approved by the County Board. This compact allows Shawano County to help and be helped from other counties with natural disaster emergencies. Shawano County landfill will be capped off, and each township will have to pay according to the agreement. Town will have to budget money and I will keep the town updated.

Public Comments: Brian Eckberg going to the Town of Chase meeting on August 11, 2022 to get information on grassing cutting. Todd Schmechel asked about drilling the blacktop to find out what is under the road causing it to heave up in the spring. Luann Schmechel asked about cutting down a cedar tree at the Krakow Park so kids can see cars on the roadway. Brian Eckberg suggested using Subservices Exploration for getting a quote on the drilling of the Lake Sandia Drive. Joe Albers asked about next year's budget and if the town was going to blacktop from Lake Sandia Drive to the Krakow Park. Robert Ripley asked about cleaning up buildings in Krakow.

Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session

- a. Nick Achtermeier, Jr. talked about the upcoming contract with Harter's Disposal. Each town resident would be getting one 95 gallon trash and one 95 gallon recycling cart. Pickup days would remain the same. Current rate is \$5.15/trash and \$1.62/recycling per household. New price would be \$7.45/trash and \$3.91/recycling per household. Carts cost \$100 to replace, garbage has to be bagged and put into carts, and recycling items are to be loose in the cart.
- b. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the Amendment to Ordinance 7-11-05~Driveways & Culverts to include "Class 3 High density polyethylene culverts"
- c. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve opening a money market account for the Hillside Cemetery Account to replace the Hillside CD.
- d. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the returning the 2% fire dues the town received back to the Pulaski Tri County Fire Department.

Specific Town Board Notice and Agenda for Upcoming Town Board Meeting: garbage contracts, driveway permit in Krakow, and Grant Bystol from the Shawano County Highway department. The next town board meeting will be held on Monday, September 12, 2022.

Voucher Listing/Payment of Bills: *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve Vouchers V-9970 through V-10000 for a total of \$44,025.65.
