

Waste Oil & Batteries

Shawano County Residents may bring used motor oil and batteries to the landfill at no charge. The landfill has a waste oil storage tank to pour the waste oil into.



Household Hazardous Waste

Shawano County residents are allowed to use the Brown County Household Hazardous Waste Facility to dispose of household hazardous wastes. Their facility is located at 2561 S. Broadway in the Village of Ashwaubenon. Shawano County residents may go to the facility on Thursday's between Noon and 6:00 p.m. and Saturday's between 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. There is no charge to county residents. Acceptable items to take there are pesticides, acids, caustics, flammable or explosive materials, infectious wastes, syringes, stains/varnishes. Please DO NOT take LATEX or OIL BASED PAINTS to the Brown County Facility. These paints can be safely disposed of.



- Get a container such as a cardboard box
- Line with a heavy plastic bag
- Use an absorbent material such as kitty litter, sawdust, sand, newspaper, etc.
- Layer of absorbent, layer of paint, let dry. Again layer of absorbent, layer of paint, let dry. Continue as necessary
- When absorbent mixture has dried, close plastic bag and put in trash
- Put empty paint container into your automated collection cart.
