Monthly Meeting December 12, 2022

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice: Chairperson Kucksdorf called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call resulted in all town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Friday, December 9, 2022. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes: *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on November 14, 2022 and the budget hearing and the special town meeting held on November 14, 2022.*

Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report: The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of November 30, 2022 of \$78,013.47 in the Premier Checking Account, \$105,538.71 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$535,727.58 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$13,784.07 in the Fox Community Credit CD, \$10 in the CoVantage Cemetery Saving Account, \$11.42 in the CoVantage ATC Savings Account, and \$5 in the Fox Community Credit Member Share Account. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

Correspondence & Clerk's Report: Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) Letter from City of Shawano increasing the tipping fees for 2023 (2) five fire incident reports from the Pulaski Tri County Fire department (3) one land use permit for single family dwelling (4) thank you from Premier Bank (5) Conditional Approval letter for Riesterer & Schnell for a new sprinkler system (6) Bonduel EMS monthly report for November. Clerk Przybylski also gave the board two emails, one for a concern about the advertising at all intersections in the town, and one for a complaint about vehicles parked on the roadway and vehicles kept in the yard.

Reports from Town Officers: Supervisor Przybylski Road Maintenance reported that he filled potholes on Carroll Road, Middle Drive, and Green Valley Road. Lake Sandia Drive was cut and sealed by Schmechel driveway, work was done by M & L Excavating. Supervisor Przybylski supervisor report (1) asked the Chairperson Kucksdorf to consider filling the shoulders on Green Valley between Highway 160 and Deer Drive. The shoulder is very low (2) the Hillside Cemetery had a burial this last month with Ike Karcz passing away (3) watched a seminar about using recycled rubber in Asphalt repaving. Some benefits are extending the life of road (4) received favorable comments about the lower speed limit in Zachow of 25 mph.

Supervisor Van Asten (1) received a question about junk and unlicensed vehicles.

Town Chairman: Chairperson Kucksdorf talked about the cat complaint in Krakow and the resident is going to try an electric fence to keep the cat in. NEW Rescue has \$134,483.50 in the equipment fund. New Ambulance is about \$260,000 to \$280,000. The box has a lifetime warranty, going to get prices on getting all new items mounted in the box. Could save about \$40,000. NEW is getting a grant for \$85,570 and they will put this into the equipment fund. NEW is going to purchase a CD for \$100,000. Lindsay Ard called about the pothole on Carroll Road, and Supervisor Przybylski filled the pothole. There is brush on the south side of Church Drive and also a tree growing in the ditch. Chairperson Kucksdorf asked about getting a copy of the ordinance pertaining to circle driveway. Contacted Jason Bergner on ditching on Willow Drive. Nicole Haas from the DNR will help them fill out the paperwork and does not see a problem with the ditch maintenance being done.

Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11: James Przybylski reported George Lenzner, Sheriff; Brian Westfahl, Coroner; Ethan Schmidt, Clerk of Circuit Court will be sworn in on January 3, 2023 at 8:15 am in Branch II of the Courthouse. Ty Raddant will be appointed as the next chief deputy.

Public Comments: Ron Banaszynski asked about who seeds the graves at the Hillside Cemetery.

Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session

- a. Mike Schuh from McKeefry & Sons Inc. answered questions about snow plowing the roads in the Town. McKeefry also plows for the Town of Pittsfield and Maple Grove. When there is a prolonged snow storm they plow twice. General rule is at least two inches of snow before we plow roads. No sand in Lake Sandia subdivision only the entrance. Board suggested coming out earlier in the morning to clean major roads before residents have to leave for work or school.
- b. Christina DuBois from GFL gave a presentation about the new garbage carts and answered any questions the board and residents at the meeting. Christina has worked for GFL for 11 years. The carts will be delivered to residents December 21 thru December 23. Instructions will be placed on the carts. Carts need to be placed five feet apart for automatic pickup. First pickup is January 12, 2023 and DO NOT start using carts until then. The complete town will be picked up every two weeks.
- c. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve sending a letter to the City of Shawano and the Shawano County Waste Management Board about using the Brown County Landfill and not the Shawano County Landfill transfer station because of logistics and cost.
- d. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to amend the Ordinance 2-8-11 Limits of Refunds and Overpayments of \$10 or less to include “that the Town of Angelica will deduct a five-dollar (\$5) processing fee on every refund”.
- e. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve changing the rental of the Town Hall from \$65 to \$75 per rental starting in 2023.
- f. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve using the current IRS rate that is to be set at the end of December for 2023.

Specific Town Board Notice and Agenda for Upcoming Town Board Meeting: Looking at driveway/culvert ordinance concerning more than one driveway. The next town board meeting will be held on Monday, January 9, 2023.
