Monthly Meeting December 13, 2021

Town Officials Present: Chairperson Richard Ferfecki, Supervisors James Przybylski and Greg Van Asten, Treasurer Lisa Matuszak and Clerk Connie Przybylski

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice: Chairperson Ferfecki called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call resulted in all town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Friday, December 10, 2021. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes: *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the budget hearing, special town meeting, and the regular board meeting held on November 8, 2021.*

Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report: The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of November 30, 2021 of \$77,716.96 in the Premier Checking Account, \$75,606.62 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$530,408.51 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$10.00 in the CoVantage Savings Account, and \$13,065.89 in the CoVantage Hillside CD Account. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

Correspondence & Clerk's Report: Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) letter from Shawano County Health Department about COVID-Safe precautions for the holiday season (2) six fire incidents reports from the Pulaski Tri County Fire department (3) one land use permit for outdoor pavilion (club house) (4) WE Energies report on a natural gas line being installed on Deer Drive to Maple Road to Highway 160 to Highway 55. The Clerk also reported on several emails received on complaints about the snow plowing work done on the east side of the Town.

Reports from Town Officers: Supervisor Przybylski Road Maintenance reported that he fixed a tipping stop sign in Krakow, removed old ATV signs, picked up old gas tank from ditch on Town Hall Drive, added gravel to shoulder at Green Valley/Town Line Road intersection. Asked Chairperson about adding delineators to guard rail on Wencel/Center Street. Supervisor Przybylski supervisor report (1) attended a zoom meeting on proven safety countermeasures for roads. Some highlights that were discussed were pavement friction, lighting, wider edge lines, and rapid flashing beacons. (2) attended zoom meeting with Wisconsin Town Association. Talked about the effects of AB610 and SB630 bills that cause a tax shift (3) called Oconto Electric about a street light out in Krakow (4) sold two plots at Hillside Cemetery (5) received several calls about the snow plowing complaints on Elm Road, Green Valley Road, and Middle Drive. The snow plowed driver left several inches of snow on road.

Supervisor Van Asten (1) asked about plowing Park Street wider in front of St. Casimir Church (2) also asked about having a tornado warning sign at the town hall.

Report from Town Planning Commission Chairman/County Board Supervisor ~ District 11 and Town Chairman: Received several complaints about the east side of Town snow plowing that was not acceptable. If the company does not do a better job the Town will find someone else to plow the roads. Elm Road was the worst road, grader came out on Sunday to remove the snow still on the roads. A resident in Krakow had a concern about snow being pushed on his property. Town residents seemed to be satisfied about their tax bills this year. The Town received the LRIP grant for Apple Road in the amount of \$20,557.55.

Planning & Zoning had two CSM to review and bring to town requirements. Nutrition Service will be adding liquid fertilizer towers and will need a conditional use permit from the Town. Shawano County rule book was updated. Squad cars are being put on a 10 year depreciation bases. Try to replace about six to seven cars a year. Shawano will be purchasing the squad cars through the state to save money. NEW Rescue average response time is eight minutes seven seconds. Average cost for call is \$1,174.33. There were 31 no transport and 69 transport calls this last month. Pulaski had 212, Pittsfield had 115, Angelica had 54, Chase had 42, Lessor had 59, Maple Grove had 31, and outside calls were 8. Assets and liabilities were \$39,938.06. Current net income is \$24,882.74.

Public Comments: Ron Banaszynski asked about the Market Adjustment that is going to be done in 2022.

Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session

- a. A listing of fifteen persons for appointment as election officials for the two-year term of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023 was reviewed. Four of these people were selected by the Democratic Party of Shawano County to act as Democratic representatives. Upon checking with these four people, it was determined that they did not want to be considered as being Democratic representatives and therefore no party affiliation was given to any of the nominees. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to appoint the following fifteen people as election officials for the two-year term of January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2023:

- e. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to release/rescind Resolution 2-22-21 of a tax lien on W290 Angelica Street for the razing of building on this property.
