**December 8, 2025**

**Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice:** Chairperson Maroszek called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call resulted in all of the town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Friday, December 5, 2025. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

**Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes:** *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Aten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on November 10, 2025, and the budget hearing and special town of electors meeting on November 10, 2025.

**Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report:** The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of November 30, 2025, of \$112,068.33 in the Premier Checking Account, \$114,874.01 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$542,987.35 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$18,868.95 in the Fox Community Credit CD, \$366.83 in the CoVantage Angelica Community Park Donations Account, \$2,052.36 in the CoVantage ATC Savings Account, and \$5 in the Fox Community Credit Member Share Account. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.

**Correspondence & Clerk's Report:** Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) three land use permits, one for an agriculture structure, one for a minor structure, and one for a freestanding sign (2) thirteen fire incident reports (3) thank you from Premier Community Bank MFL Order (5) Bonduel EMS report for November. Clerk Przybylski reported that she received a call from David Giese about Town Hall Drive not being plowed on November 30. David was told to call the Chair Maroszek and given the chair's phone number, then David called me back and told me that Chair Maroszek told him that I was to take care of it. I asked Chair Maroszek why you told him to call me when this is your job.

**Reports from Town Officers:** Supervisor Van Asten reported that (1) received an estimate for gutter topplers from H&H Seamless Gutters (2) received a call from David Marcks about how to mark down hours for cleaning the Angelica Community Park. Supervisor Eckberg reported that (1) he attended the Pulaski Tri County Fire Department meeting, and the new tender has not been received yet (2) attended the NEW Rescue meeting (3) received a call about snowplowing.

**Town Chairperson:** Chairperson Maroszek reported that he received a call from Bill Krause about Karcz Nation driving their manure trucks on the roads. He also received a call from David Giese about snow plowing, received a call about shipping containers, and received a call from Harvey Reinke about the subdivision on Church Drive. Chair Maroszek reprimanded the clerk for misspelling his name wrong on the directory insert that was in the tax bills, after reviewing the insert the clerk missed an "l" in the Chair's first name.

**Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11:** James Przybylski reported that in the 2026 County asphalt paving schedule, I am happy to inform the Town residents that Shawano County has one of our roads on the list, it is County Road F from Highway 29 to Zachow Road which is 2.21 miles. Debra Wallace, Shawano County Treasurer, has announced her retirement which will take effect on December 19, 2025. Debra has worked in this position for 16 years and I would like to wish her well on her new adventure. James Przybylski also reported that Kurt Berner of Samuels Group introduced Kory Beyer from Venture Construction who presented a general assessment of the County Buildings and recommendations for the future. Also, Carol Ann Wirth presented preliminary tax calculations referencing the long-term effects. The Shawano County Highway Department is looking for mechanics and drivers. If you know someone looking for a career, not just a job, they can apply online or just go down to the Highway Department.

**Public Comments:** Ralph Janiack wants to comment on the shipping containers when it comes up later on the agenda.

- b. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the Fees for Services with no changes.
- c. *MOTION (Eckberg/Maroszek/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the increase for election officials to \$18/hour for Chief Election Inspectors and \$15/hour for Election Officials.  
*MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the increase for town hall cleaning and repair and general maintenance to \$16/hour.  
*MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the increase for Angelica Community Park cleaning and maintenance to \$16/hour.  
*MOTION (Eckberg/Maroszek/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the increase for road signing and road maintenance to \$18/hour.

- d. Discussion took place on shipping containers. Nick Ambrosius asked if there was any change in allowing shipping containers. Shawano County Planning & Zoning discussed shipping containers at the September 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting. There was input from four towns, under Shawano County Zoning, and the Committee decided to keep the rules as they are. Shipping containers are not allowed under Shawano County Zoning except if you had it before 2019.
- e. Discussion took place about the snow plowing in the town. Shawano County plows roads west of Elm Road, which takes about eight hours, and McKeefry & Sons plows roads to the east of and including Elm Road.
- f. Discussion took place on animal control in the town. Chair Maroszek tells residents to call the Shawano County Humane Society.
- g. Discussion took place on Karcz Nation driving their manure and feed trucks on town roads. Chair Maroszek received a call from Bill Krause and Bill did not like all the trucks traveling on the roads. Jacob and Dillon Karcz said they would post on Facebook when they will be driving, what roads will be traveled, how many days it may take, and they take one road to the farm and another from the farm to cut down on the number of trucks having to cross on the same road. This information will provide notice to residents who walk, bike, or travel on the roads.

**Specific Town Board Notice and Agenda for Upcoming Town Board Meeting:** Draft of Recycling Ordinance and estimate for gutter covers for the Town Hall. The next town board meeting will be held on Monday, January 12, 2026.
