Monthly Meeting

February 9, 2026

Town Officials Present: Chairperson Allan Maroszek, Supervisors Brian Eckberg and Greg Van Asten, Treasurer Lisa Matuszak, and Clerk Connie Przybylski

**Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice:** Chairperson Maroszek called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call resulted in all the town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Thursday, February 5, 2026. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

**Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes:** *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on January 12, 2026*

**Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report:** The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of January 31, 2026, of \$93,034.89 in the Premier Checking Account, \$1,529,897.71 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$545,493.46 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$19,217.07 in the Fox Community Credit CD, \$367.15 in the CoVantage Angelica Community Park Donations Account, \$2,560.34 in the CoVantage ATC Savings Account, and \$5 in the Fox Community Credit Member Share Account. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

**Correspondence & Clerk's Report:** Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) two land use permits, one for a single-family dwelling, one for an accessory nonresidential structure (2) nine fire incident reports (3) Bonduel EMS report for January. Clerk Przybylski read an email from a resident about the snow plowing done on various roads where the plow dug up huge chunks of the ditch, dirt, and grass and wondered whose responsibility it is to fix.

**Reports from Town Officers:** Supervisor Van Asten reported that he received the bid for the gutter covers for the Town Hall. Supervisor Eckberg reported that (1) he attended the NEW Rescue meeting and everything seems to be going good and there was a small surplus (2) he attended the Pulaski Fire Department meeting and the next meeting will be in April, finances look okay, and there was update to the bylaws (3) issued a driveway/culvert permit.

**Town Chairperson:** Chairperson Maroszek reported that he received a call from Randy Holewinski from the Town of Maple Grove. Randy wanted to know if the town would be interested in a combined day for tire recycling. Tentative day would be April 11 from 9 am until noon. Chairperson Maroszek reported about putting a manure spreader on the end on Julius Street for grass clippings and then emptied when full on a farm field. Robert Kuczer of Kuczer Hillside Lumber LLC will take clean brush but will reject any brush that contains leaves or grass clippings. Chairperson Maroszek brought up the clerk hours at the town hall. Chair Maroszek talked about the solar panels that Shawano County is anticipating putting on the Maple Lane County owned land.

**Public Comments:** Bryan Kolodziej asked about the snowplow turf roll and be careful and don't open a can of worms trying to fix all roads. Lauren Bender asked about an audit. Treasurer Matuszak, Supervisor Van Asten, and Clerk Przybylski informed her of the process to ensure transparency.

**Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session:**

- a. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve Conditional Use permit CU-1-26 Non-Metallic Mineral Extraction for Tom Maroszek for 10 years.
- b. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the temporary Class B Beverage License for St. Casimir Congregation Fish Fries.
- c. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the Recycling Ordinance 2-9-26.
- d. *MOTION (Maroszek/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve H & H Seamless Cutters to install gutter covers, clean gutters, change corners, and fix downspouts as needed for a cost of \$2,125 with work to be completed in 2026.
- e. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the amendment to the Adoption of Wisconsin Uniform Dwelling Code 3-9-2020. The update includes in section 1.4 “Wisconsin Admin, Code Ch. SPS 320-325, and Uniform Dwelling Code, and SPS 327, Camping Units, their successors”.
- f. Clerk Przybylski supplied the Board with a sample of an advertisement for bid for the Lake Sandia Phase I road paving project. Discussion took place on the wording of the bid, when the project should be bid out. Chair Maroszek will be talking to contractors about the project. It was the general consensus of the board to take this up at a later meeting.
- g. Discussion took place on AI Data Centers that are going up in the state of Wisconsin. Supervisor Van Asten is concerned about the effects it will have on the town resources and residents. The Town Board will wait to see if Shawano County Planning & Zoning will be addressing this concern.

**Specific Town Board Notice and Agenda for Upcoming Town Board Meeting:** Grass cutting quotes, tire drop off, AI Data Center, and brush cutting. The next town board meeting will be held on Monday, March 9, 2026.

**Voucher Listing/Payment of Bills:** *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve Vouchers V-11290 through V-11319 for a total of \$63,225.06.
