

- H. ATV/UTV's traveling on Town roads shall travel on the right side of the road, in single file, and with headlights on at a rate of speed not to exceed 35 MPH. (See item B above for other speed limitations)
- I. When operating an ATV/UTV under this ordinance, if the ATV/UTV has no turn signals and/or brake lights, the operator shall use hand signals when making turns or stopping.
- J. No public or private landowner shall be liable for any property damage or personal injury sustained by any person operating or riding as a passenger on an ATV/UTV or upon a vehicle or other device drawn by an ATV/UTV upon the public or private landowner's property, whether or not the public or private landowner has given permission to use the land unless the public or private landowner charges a cash fee to the operator or owner of the ATV/UTV for the use of the property or unless damage or injury is intentionally inflicted by the landowner.
- K. ATV/UTV operators must remain on the approved marked ATV/UTV Trail or ATV/UTV Route or DNR and other penalties will apply.
- L. No ATV operators under age 12 and no UTV operators under age 16 may operate on a public roadway for any reason.
- M. All ATV/UTV operators and passengers under the age of 18 are required to wear a minimum DOT standard ATV or motorcycle helmet. Bicycle helmets do not meet this requirement.
- N. All UTV passengers must have their seatbelts fastened at all times. It is illegal for a passenger to ride in or on any part of a UTV that is not originally designed or intended by the manufacturer to be used by passengers. It is not legal to operate with passengers in any after-market seating placed in the cargo area of the UTV.

Section 8. Severability:

Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional, or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected.

Section 9. Enforcement:

The Town of Angelica Board of Supervisors gives the authority to enforce this ordinance to the State of Wisconsin Highway Patrol, Shawano County Sheriff's Department, Town of Angelica Chairperson, or their designee, and/or the Town Board of Supervisors or their designee, and any other enforcement authority as allowed by Wisconsin Statutes.

The enforcement officer may order the owner or operator of any vehicle being operated on a highway to suspend operation.

Verbal or written warnings may be allowed at the discretion of the enforcement authority in the above paragraph.

Section 10. Effective Date: This ordinance is effective on publication or posting. The town clerk shall properly publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. Stats.
