

# TOWN OF ANGELICA

## Monthly Meeting

January 12, 2026

Town Officials Present: Chairperson Allan Maroszek, Supervisors Brian Eckberg and Greg Van Asten, Treasurer Lisa Matuszak, and Clerk Connie Przybylski

**Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice:** Chairperson Maroszek called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call resulted in all the town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Wednesday, January 7, 2026. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

**Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes:** *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on December 8, 2025 with a correction that Chair Maroszek spoke to Shawano County about the time it takes to plow snow in the town.*

**Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report:** The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of December 31, 2025, of \$104,390.18 in the Premier Checking Account, \$1,156,621.90 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$544,238.96 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$19,043.01 in the Fox Community Credit CD, \$366.99 in the CoVantage Angelica Community Park Donations Account, \$2,559.26 in the CoVantage ATC Savings Account, and \$5 in the Fox Community Credit Member Share Account. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

**Correspondence & Clerk's Report:** Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) three land use permits, one for a single-family dwelling, one for a shoreland disturbance area, and one for a waster transfer system modification (2) seven fire incident reports (3) Bonduel EMS report for December. Clerk Przybylski reported that she attended the WMCA meeting on December 9 and topics discussed were Alcohol Beverage updates and election training. On December 16 she attended a zoom meeting with Dempsey Law on open meetings and public records training. Clerk Przybylski received several tax and garbage related questions, she also received a call from a resident that found a street sign in his yard. The street sign did not belong to the Town of Angelica, so she gave him the Town of Chase phone number. On January 7 she also received questions about lowering the speed limit on Middle Drive and about coming up with an Ordinance banning AI date centers from coming into the Town of Angelica. Clerk Przybylski reported that the town will not need a February primary and supplied phone numbers from the Shawano County Humane Society to the town board for animals running at large in the town.

**Reports from Town Officers:** Supervisor Van Asten reported that (1) received a call from Kevin Carlson at W818 Cuba Drive about the snow plow wrecking his property with the wing of the plow (2) getting estimate for the gutter toppers from H & H Seamless Gutters (3) asked the board to wait until spring to install fire numbers due to the frost in the ground. Supervisor Eckberg reported that he had trouble with a culvert permit and he wants the permits sent to him not the clerk.

**Town Chairperson:** Chairperson Maroszek reported that he talked to Wisconsin DOT about the upcoming roadwork on Highway 29 and received a call from the Shawano County Sheriff department

about a resident that took a cat in and the cat started fighting with her cat, the resident got bit and needed the cat removed. Chair Maroszek also reported on the boring company will be doing boring on the bridges on Green Valley Road and Elm Road. The Pulaski School District has issues with getting through the area by the bridge. Chair Maroszek also received complaints about Karcz trucks on the roads.

**Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11:** James Przybylski reported that Kurt Berner of Samuels Group and Kory Beyer of Venture provided on update on the master planning and the possible future building design. Berner reported that the final site, adjacent to the current jail and courthouse, has been selected for the future site. On January 14 County Supervisors will be touring Green Lake and Waushara County facilities for flow and layout possibilities. On December 11 the Solid Waste Board approved the Memorandum of Understanding that was then sent to the County Board at the December 17 meeting which was approved by the board. Shawano County agrees to the transfer and assign all responsibility to the City of Shawano regarding the cost of the closure including the timing, sequencing of stockpiles and modification of the closure plan. The City of Shawano will give a report once a year on their progress to the Shawano County Board. Nick Mau, Health Officer Director of Shawano-Menominee Counties, gave an update on his departments ground water testing project. Nick reported that with a \$10K grant and additional Shawano County Land Conservation funds, well testing will occur in eastern portion of Shawano County specifically Towns of Angelica, Maple Grove, Hartland, Lessor, and Green Valley. There were inserts with you tax statements informing you of the water testing. James Przybylski also had some handouts available on the back table that are good reading material from Shawano County Health Department.

**Public Comments:** Ken Simons asked about the hourly cost of an excavator, every year we wait to take care of brush it costs more, and I would like to see you put brushing out for bids. Andrea Schaller asked about yard waste, the paving of Lake Sandia Drive, and Andrea also reported on the snow plowing in Krakow that was not done in a timely matter and snow got packed down on the roads. Ralph Janiak brought up the snow plowing on Green Valley Road and how McKeefry ruined the shoulders and residents' yards.

#### **Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session:**

- a. Discussion took place on the contract for ProCheck Inspections LLC to become the new town building inspector. Mike Miller at Miller Inspections is reducing his workload and will be ending his role as of March 31, 2026. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve ProCheck Inspections LLC, Bryan Lauritzen, as the new building inspector effective on state approval with 100% of fees collected to be retained by ProCheck Inspections, LLC.
- b. Clerk Przybylski supplied the town board with the updates to the recycling ordinance that are required by the Department of Natural Resources to continue receiving the recycling grant. This will be adopted at the next town board meeting.
- c. Supervisor Van Asten will be getting the estimate for H & H Seamless Gutters to install gutter toppers at the Angelica Town Hall. This also will be taken up at the next town meeting.
- d. Discussion took place on the compost site. Residents can bring their yard waste, grass clipping, etc. to the Shawano County Landfill site at 1099 Rusch Road Shawano or call 715-524-2230.

**Specific Town Board Notice and Agenda for Upcoming Town Board Meeting:** Recycling Ordinance and estimate for gutter covers for the Town Hall. The next town board meeting will be held on Monday, February 9, 2026.

**Voucher Listing/Payment of Bills:** *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve Vouchers V-11261 through V-11289 for a total of \$1,008,059.54.
