January 17, 2022

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice: Supervisor Van Asten called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call resulted in town officials being shown as present with Chairperson Richard Ferfecki absent. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Friday, January 14, 2022. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes: *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on December 13, 2021.*

Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report: The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of December 31, 2021 of \$86,586.99 in the Premier Checking Account, \$842,700.36 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$530,655.76 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$670.36 in the CoVantage Savings Account, and \$13,065.89 in the CoVantage Hillside CD Account. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

Correspondence & Clerk's Report: Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) the Spring Primary on February 15, 2022 is for only the Pulaski School District and the Town of Angelica will be combining polls with Town of Maple Grove, Town of Lessor, and Town of Green Valley. All will be at the Town of Angelica Town Hall (2) eleven fire incidents reports from the Pulaski Tri County Fire department (3) two land use permits, one for a single family dwelling and one for an accessory dwelling unit (4) Bonduel EMS monthly report for November and December.

Reports from Town Officers: Supervisor Przybylski Road Maintenance reported that he added delineators to guard rails on Wencel/Julius Street and Main Street in Krakow. Cleared fallen trees from roads in Zachow, Krakow, Middle Drive, and Birch Road from wind storm. Supervisor Przybylski supervisor report (1) received two concerns from Zachow residents about barrels being used as a fence between property lines; silver Dodge vehicle parked on Northwestern Ave in the way for snow plowing (2) issued a driveway/culvert permit for a new house on Pine Road (3) Natural gas line being installed for Bentley farms in coming down Highway 160 to Highway 55. I asked WE Energies if they would consider installing gas line into the hamlet of Angelica. If enough interest from residents could be installed and letters will be sent out to residents in hamlet of Angelica.

Supervisor Van Asten (1) received a call from a resident about a house in Krakow on the Sheriff's sale.

Report from Town Planning Commission Chairman/County Board Supervisor ~ District 11 and Town Chairperson: Chairperson Richard Ferfecki absent.

Public Comments: James Mills asked about the storage containers in the agriculture rural areas.

Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session

- a. Discussion took place on the storage/shipping containers ordinance. Supervisor Przybylski discussed that Shawano County Planning and Zoning held a meeting on January 5, 2022 which they discussed updating shipping containers in the Zoning Ordinance. Supervisor Przybylski suggested that we just follow Shawano County Ordinance when updated instead of having our own ordinance.
- b. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve operator’s license for Andrew Cherry, Paul Lueckfeld, Ashley Byrnes, Linda Peterson.
