Monthly Meeting

March 9, 2020

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice: Chairman Ferfecki called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call resulted in all town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Thursday, March 5, 2020. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes: *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on February 10, 2020 and the special town meeting on February 17, 2020.*

Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report: The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of February 29, 2020 of \$0.00 in the Associated Bank Checking Account, this account is now closed, \$12,449.73 in the new Premier Checking Account, \$335,132.99 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$629,080.97 in the Huntington National Bank Investment Insured Cash Sweep Account. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

Correspondence & Clerk's Report: Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) a letter from shawano county zoning on their upcoming meeting (2) one land use permit for an agricultural structure and one change of 911 number (3) four incident reports from the Pulaski Tri-county Fire Department (4) Bonduel EMS Monthly report for March (8) school district of Bonduel minutes and agendas for February and March.

Reports from Town Officers: Supervisor Przybylski Road Maintenance reported that he filled pot holes on Green Valley Road, Elm Road also picked up trash and a tire on Green Valley, Elm and Town Hall Roads; and put gravel in four dips on Beech Drive. Supervisor Przybylski Supervisory report (1) went to WTA meeting in the Town of Herman. They talked about the MLS grant; cyber security; survey markers at intersections; Tony Kordus introduced himself, he is running for Circuit Court Judge; Grant Bristol talked about upcoming projects and the price of blacktop went down \$2/ton (2) went to Wisconsin Asphalt Pavement Association meeting, they talked about road construction practices, proper setting of culverts, and John Gard gave a road transportation update. (3) Would like to get pricing on some improvements for Krakow community Park, such as new nets for volleyball and tennis courts, seal tennis court, trim trees, new basketball hoop and net, and update security lights.

Supervisor Van Asten reported (1) received a complaint about the trees blocking the visibility on Center Street and Highway 32, and the trees create ice on road (2) Have a 911 number to install when it dries out (3) check the water level on some roads (4) I object to the fact that the MLS Grant went mostly to bike trails and not roadwork.

Report from Town Planning Commission Chairman/County Board Supervisor ~ District 11 and Town Chairman:

Chairman Ferfecki reported that the weight limits went on early because roads are breaking up due to early thaw. Shawano County is working on the comprehensive plan to include “party barns” and it will be until June before it is finalized. Second Amendment is being talked about and the sheriff has authority to uphold the constitution. The County is not changing the constitution. New jail locks and computer system are being installed. Looking at radio reception in the County/Nichols area and may rent a space on Oconto County towers. Planning and Zoning has residents interested but none have sent in the paperwork. Pulaski Tri-county Fire Department is replacing their insurance company with a better insurance coverage. They are going to create their own training center, Schneider Transport is donating containers. They have 34 members, Angelica had no fire calls, new LED lighting is installed, and next meeting is April 28 at 7:30 pm. Weight limits went on March 5 on the Town roads.

Sign Maintenance person: Elmer Kraning not present.

Public Comments: Grant Bristol and Hunter Hoffman came from the Shawano County Highway Department. Talked about the snow plowing in the Town and how they balance cost verses service to the Town to save on budgets. The County has a night watchmen to monitor weather situations. Weight limits went into effect March 9. Susan Pomprowitz said that there are cracks on Angelica Street from Green Valley to Main Street. Ray Warden talked about snow plowing on Center Street and that the stop sign was not plowed out. Also talked about the snowmobile trail on Angelica Street that the snowmobile have no snow to drive on. Discussion followed about moving the trail and to address the situation in the future. ATV signage is not installed and about the speed limit in the Town is 10 mph.

Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session

- a. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the operator’s license for Logan Lom.
- b. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve Maroszek Outdoor Care to cut grass at a cost of \$35 per cutting for Town Hall, \$75 for Hillside Cemetery, and \$105 for Krakow Park.
- c. *MOTION (Van Asten/Ferfecki//PASSED)* to approve waiting until May to approve the Contract for Revaluation/Market Adjustment for 2021.
- d. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the Ordinance 3-09-2020 Wisconsin Uniform Dwelling Code/Building Permit to include adding “a non-residential building, such as a barn or tavern, which is converted to a dwelling” to Scope 1.3. Taking out “in excess of 150 sq. ft.” and “in an amount over \$5,000”.
- e. The Town Board reviewed information to be contained in the March newsletter that will be mailed out with the Annual Financial Report.
- f. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve pricing for tires at a cost of \$4 car/truck; \$7 semi; and \$14 tractor.

Specific Town Board Notice and Agenda for Upcoming Town Board Meeting: The next town board meeting will be held on Monday, April 13, 2020. Possible items for the agenda storm sewer in Krakow, bid for Elm Road, town building permits ordinance, Krakow park improvements, new member for Planning Committee.

Voucher Listing/Payment of Bills: *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve Vouchers V-9014 through V-9046 for a total of \$33,631.30.
