**Monthly Meeting**

**March 9, 2026**

**Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice:** Chairperson Maroszek called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll call resulted in all the town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Thursday, March 5, 2026. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

**Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes:** *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on February 9, 2026*

**Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report:** The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of February 28, 2026, of \$11,437.94 in the Premier Checking Account, \$561,373.87 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$546,629.17 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$19,217.07 in the Fox Community Credit CD, \$367.22 in the CoVantage Angelica Community Park Donations Account, \$2,560.83 in the CoVantage ATC Savings Account, and \$5 in the Fox Community Credit Member Share Account. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

**Correspondence & Clerk's Report:** Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) two land use permits, one for a contractor shop, one for an accessory residential structure (2) news release from Shawano County on the weight limits becoming effective on March 11, 2026 (3) Managed Forest Law Transfer Order (4) Notification from Wisconsin Dept of Safety & Professional Services for the completion of the Dollar General in Krakow (5) Report from ProCheck Inspections on the latest building permits issued for the Town (6) Bonduel EMS report for February. Clerk Przybylski reported that she attended the WTA Shawano Unit Meeting on February 26 in Belle Plaine. Grant Bystol reported on the amended ATV/UTV Ordinance and would like unity across Shawano County and Grant also reported on the upcoming roads that will be done in 2026; Matt Hieptas, IT Director, reported on the BEAD funding and broadband across Shawano County, and Matt reported on the services that the Shawano County IT Department can offer to the towns; Wyatt Farrar gave a presentation from Tony Wied's office; Senator Eric Wimberger reported on the broadband and PFAS, James Przybylski, District 11 Supervisor, asked Senator Wimberger about the PFAS that AI Data Centers can produce. Clerk Przybylski reported that Open Book will be May 12 from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm, and Board of Review will be May 19 starting at 5:00 pm.

**Reports from Town Officers:** Supervisor Van Asten had no report. Supervisor Eckberg reported that he has been working on the state-owned land on Cherry Drive.

**Town Chairperson:** Chairperson Maroszek reported that he received a call from Scott Wudtke about a damaged culvert pipe on Main Street in Zachow from work done by TDS; received a call from Todd Schmechel about his concrete driveway heaving on North Lake Sandia Drive; received a call from Susan Pomprowitz about her preference of putting the manure spreader at the Angelica Community Park in Krakow and not at the dead end on Julius Street.

**Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11:** James Przybylski reported the County Board thanked Lori Gagner for 30 years of great service as the assistant real property lister. Lori was a great asset to the Planning & Zoning Department and her knowledge and attention to detail will be missed. James Przybylski also reported on the Master Plan for possible changes for the building footprint continues. There will be information meetings at three different places, all starting at 6 pm, first will be on March 16, 2026, at the Shawano Community High School, next on March 16, 2026, at Bonduel High School, and the final on March 17, 2026, at the Wittenberg-Birnamwood High School. Shawano County is sending a letter to all residents with more information on this possible plan, and there is a website page on the county website to view all possibilities. I would like to encourage all residents to attend and share their view on what is presented.

**Public Comments:** Ron Banaczynski reported about tires in the ditch on Elm Road just south of Middle Drive. Ralph Janiak asked when the town weight limits are going to be put on and suggested a standard time of March 1 through April 15.

**Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session:**

- a. *MOTION (Eckberg/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve Conditional Use permit CU-2-26 to construct a single-family dwelling in C-G zoning for Bill Kuchtz Sr.
- b. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to accept the grass cutting quotes for Maroszek Outdoor Care for the Angelica Town Hall at a cost of \$55 per cutting, spring cleanup at a cost of \$55, fall cleanup for a cost of \$55; Maroszek Outdoor Care for the Hillside Cemetery at a cost of \$110 per cutting, spring cleanup at a cost of \$110, fall cleanup at a cost of \$110; Vomastic Lawn Care for the Angelica Community Park at a cost of \$100 per cutting, spring cleanup at a cost of \$100, fall cleanup at a cost of \$100; Vomastic Lawn Care for the Zachow parcels at a cost of \$50 per cutting, spring cleanup at a cost of \$100, fall cleanup at a cost of \$100.
- c. Discussion took place on the combined tire pickup with Maple Grove. The tire pickup will be on April 11, 2026, from 9 am to noon located at Maple Grove town hall site (corner of Laney & Redwood) with prices of vehicle tires \$2.50 each, implement tires \$5 each, and tractor tire \$20 each with a onetime \$10 credit. *MOTION (Van Asten/Eckberg/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve having a combined tire pickup with Maple Grove on April 11, 2026.
- d. Discussion took place on brush cutting. Chair Maroszek is waiting for the snow to melt and getting quotes.
- e. Discussion took place on AI Data Centers. Supervisor Van Asten asked James Przybylski if Shawano County is working on a plan. James Przybylski, District 11 Supervisor, reported that he has reached out to Matt Hieptas, IT Director, Kyle Waelchli, Zoning Administrator, and Kathy Luepke, Chair for the Shawano County Planning & Zoning Committee, to set up guidelines for AI Data Centers. James Przybylski reported about the concerns of water usage, electric power usage, and possible PFAS used in the cooling process. With the many concerns around the state, the Shawano County Planning & Zoning Committee is planning to have this on their next agenda to discuss how to move forward.
- f. Discussion took place on the state-owned land on Cherry Drive. Supervisor Eckberg presented his thoughts on talking to the Wisconsin DOT to deed the land to the town.

**Specific Town Board Notice and Agenda for Upcoming Town Board Meeting:** ATV/UTV Ordinance, Audit, AI Data Center, and brush cutting. The next town board meeting will be held on Monday, April 13, 2026.
