Monthly Meeting

May 9, 2022

Town Officials Present: Chairperson Richard Kucksdorf, Supervisors James Przybylski and Greg Van Asten, Treasurer Lisa Matuszak and Clerk Connie Przybylski

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice: Chairperson Kucksdorf called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call resulted in all town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Wednesday, May 4, 2022. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes: *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on April 11, 2022.*

Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report: The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of April 30, 2022 of \$43,634.54 in the Premier Checking Account, \$364,861.75 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$531,612.10 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$670.93 in the CoVantage Savings/Cemetery Account, and \$13,098.43 in the CoVantage Hillside CD Account. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

Correspondence & Clerk's Report: Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) Notice of cancellation letter for Performance Excavating right-of-way bond (2) five fire incidents reports from the Pulaski Tri County Fire department (3) four land use permits one for a solar energy system, one for an accessory residential structure, one for single family addition, and one for an agriculture soybean oil refinery (4) letter from WI Department of Agriculture about the bird flu being found in Oconto and Fond du Lac Counties (5) letter from WI Department of Revenue about the amount of the personal property aid (6) Bonduel EMS monthly report from March and April. The Clerk also reported that the town received a sub grant from Wisconsin Election Commission in the amount of \$407.71 for the updating the clerk email to wi.gov. The Clerk also reported on the results from the tire pickup, with a total 47 tires being collected.

Reports from Town Officers: Supervisor Przybylski Road Maintenance reported that he patched potholes on Spruce, Hillside, Carrol, Cedar, Beech, Short, Green Valley, Elm, Middle, Deer, and Lake Sandia Dr. Also blacktopped at the new culvert on Middle Drive. Asked the Chair to look at adding gravel to shoulders on Beech Drive Cedar and Carrol, Middle Drive between Green Valley and Highway 32, and Spruce Road between West Deer and gas station. Replaced stop sign and post on Town Line/Elm intersection and the street signs are on order for same intersection. Supervisor Przybylski supervisor report (1) Roger Neumann called and wanted two Deer Crossing signs on Green Valley between Cuba and Middle Drive (2) Kevin Kraemer called and wanted a No Engine Braking sign on Mile Drive west of County Road C (3) Darin Schultz has a written complaint about a road cross culvert & ditching next to his field on Town Hall Drive. Would like the board to take a look at and discuss next month (4) attended a webinar and state will be updating flood hazard maps and water shed maps. Maps will be digital and will take one to two years to complete.

Supervisor Van Asten (1) did the tire pickup on April 22 (2) participated in the Board of Review training online (3) will be opening up the Krakow park and doing the water test (4) received a complaint about chickens running around in Krakow (5) inquired about the update on grocery store in Krakow

Town Chairman: Chairperson Kucksdorf reported that he met with Matt Zierden and discussed the upcoming road work. Deer Drive project will start mid-June. Street sweeping will be done and will call chair when coming into the Town, Nichols Drive washout can be handled by adding pulverized residue and ditching. Lake Sandia property with complaint about driveway, owner used blacktop road as form and blacktop is under the concrete. A resident asked about ditching on Cedar Road. Attended the WTA workshop and participated in the Board of Review training. Met with Jeff Herrling from Crack Filling Service and discussed crack sealing two miles of Nichols Drive and two miles of Town Hall Drive for a cost of \$20,000 to \$22,000.

Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11: James Przybylski reported that the County elected Tom Kautza as Chairperson, Kevin Conradt as Vice-Chairperson. County Clerk Pam Schmidt is retiring and Kara Skarlupka was appointed to fill the rest of term.

Public Comments: Brian Eckberg asked about spending the money in the ATC account because of the deflation of the dollar. James Mills talked about using the ATC money for projects the whole town can benefit from. Ray Warden asked about street sweeping In Krakow, and about the number of people living in a single family dwelling. Susan Pomprowitz asked about chickens in Krakow.

Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session

- a. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve Austin Wall as the sign maintenance person.
- b. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to send Shawano County the complaint about the property in Zachow under Ordinance No. 4-19. Property owner did not clean up anything on the property.
- c. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the town has no intension on the development of the Pine Road extension and also is not in the budget.
- d. Discussion took place on the appointment of alternates for the Board of Review. One alternate is needed. Town will discuss at May meeting about possible alternates.
- e. Discussion took place on the 2022 budget and upcoming road work to be done with the increase of prices of blacktop.

Specific Town Board Notice and Agenda for Upcoming Town Board Meeting: operator’s license, alcohol license, tobacco license, board of review alternate, and condition of old grocery store in Krakow. The next town board meeting will be held on Monday, June 13, 2022.
