Monthly Meeting November 14, 2022

Town Officials Present: Chairperson Richard Kucksdorf, Supervisors James Przybylski and Greg Van Asten, Treasurer Lisa Matuszak, and Clerk Connie Przybylski

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice: Chairperson Kucksdorf called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call resulted in all town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Friday, November 9, 2022. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes: *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on October 10, 2022, special town meeting on October 17, 2022 and special town meeting on October 25, 2022.*

Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report: The Treasurer's report was read by Treasurer Matuszak showing balances as of October 31, 2022 of \$74,018.32 in the Premier Checking Account, \$105,473.69 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$534,749.64 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$13,785.90 in the CoVantage Cemetery Money Market Account, \$10 in the CoVantage Cemetery Saving Account, and \$11.42 in the CoVantage ATC Savings Account. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

Correspondence & Clerk's Report: Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) Letter from Shawano Health Department about checking your carbon monoxide detectors (2) six fire incident reports from the Pulaski Tri County Fire department (3) one land use permit for an accessory residential structure addition (4) letter from Rural Mutual Insurance (5) letter from DNR for managed forest law transfer order (6) bridge inspection reports done by Shawano County (7) Bonduel EMS monthly report for October. Clerk Przybylski also reported on the November 8 election results. Clerk Przybylski, with permission from Chairperson, is going to have the lawyer look into the contract with the City of Shawano and Shawano County Landfill.

Reports from Town Officers: Supervisor Przybylski Road Maintenance reported that he checked roads, filled potholes, checked signs and gave list to Austin Wall. Allan Maroszek fixed guardrail on Nichols Drive by bridge. Received a call of mud on Deer Drive by Nutrition Service, talked to the manager and Nutrition Service cleaned off the road and said they would be blacktopping parking lot. M&L Excavating will cut and seal road/driveway issue on Lake Sandia Drive for \$220. Supervisor Przybylski supervisor report (1) issued a driveway permit on Town Hall Drive for Wes Vomastic (2) natural gas line has been installed in the hamlet of Angelica and Shawano County added a manhole on County C/Highway 160 intersection (3) attended Wisconsin Towns Association 75th year convention. Speakers were Richard Stadelman, Tommy Thompson, Tim Hanna, and Tom Mosgaller (wrote book called Bending Granite). Topics were dealing with difficulty, skills, and strategies; planning for renewable energy systems; building broadband; solar regulations; bugs in Wisconsin and how to handle.

Supervisor Van Asten (1) received a complaint about a cat killing/scaring birds in Krakow. Suggested writing a letter to the neighbor, which did not resolve the issue.

Town Chairman: Chairperson Kucksdorf talked about Randy Holewinski pulling a gravity box and axle broke on Deer Drive. Holewinski contracted Maroszek to repair the road. Chairperson Kucksdorf talked to Jason Bergner's wife about maintaining the field ditch leading to Willow Road. She stated that there should not be an issue with the DNR just have to fill out paper work, Received a call from Carol Staszak about rats in the hamlet of Zachow, Carol states they are because of the barrels on the neighbor's property. If Town wants to go before the Shawano County Review board it will cost \$400. Chairperson Kucksdorf will see if he can now pursue it from the health aspect to address the issue of the barrels and rats.

Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11: James Przybylski reported that the county budget is approved and mill rate is 4.3%. Shawano County employees will receive a 6% raise. 911 system received a grant will upgrade which will add texting and video to communication center.

Public Comments: Ron Banaszynski asked about the garbage and recycling carts. Susan Pomprowitz asked about the complaint in Zachow and town having to pay \$400 to go Before the Review Board at the County.

- a. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the 2022 budget and set the town 2021 tax levy at the rate approved at the special town meeting which was held earlier in the evening. The mill rate is 2.478801649 and results in a levy of \$441,834.00
- b. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the Ninth Amendment to the Ambulance Service Agreement with Gold Cross Ambulance Service Inc.
- c. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the operator's license for Christopher Druckrey for Krakow One Stop.
- d. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve opening a seven-month CD at Fox Community Credit Union for the Hillside Cemetery Account for a rate of 4.0%
- e. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to appoint Ronald Smurawa for a six-year term as commission for the Krakow Sanitary District which will expire December 6, 2028.
- f. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY)* to approve the quote from Performance Excavating Inc. for ditching on Willow Road for an amount of \$3850.00 and to approve the quote from Performance Excavating Inc. for ditching on Apple Road for an amount of \$22,237.53.
- g. A review of last year's December newsletter and items to include in this year's December newsletter that will go out with tax statements was discussed. Discussion included adding snow plowing into the road, and the new garbage contract.
