

TOWN OF ANGELICA

Monthly Meeting September 12, 2022

Town Officials Present: Chairperson Richard Kucksdorf, Supervisors James Przybylski and Greg Van Asten, Treasurer Lisa Matuszak, and Clerk Connie Przybylski
Town Officials Absent: None

Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance/Roll Call/Verification of Meeting Notice: Chairperson Kucksdorf called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Roll call resulted in all town officials being shown as present. The Clerk verified that the agenda was posted at the town hall, on the town's website, e-mailed to the Shawano Leader, on Wednesday, September 7, 2022. *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to allow modification of the agenda if necessary.*

Approval of Prior Town Board Minutes: *MOTION (Przybylski/Van Asten/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on August 8, 2022.*

Approval of Treasurer's Monthly Report: The Treasurer's report was read by Clerk Przybylski showing balances as of August 31, 2022 of \$284,641.04 in the Premier Checking Account, \$365,187.82 in the Premier Bank Advantage Tax Account and \$533,529.59 in the CoVantage ATC Account, \$13,768.52 in the CoVantage Cemetery Money Market Account, \$10 in the CoVantage Cemetery Saving Account, and \$11.42 in the CoVantage ATC Savings Account. *MOTION (Van Asten/Przybylski/PASSED UNANIMOUSLY) to approve the Treasurer's report as presented.*

Correspondence & Clerk's Report: Clerk Przybylski presented correspondence received which consisted of (1) Laboratory report for the Krakow Park showing no bacteria in the water (2) four fire incident reports from the Pulaski Tri County Fire department (3) five land use permits, one for a single family dwelling, two for an accessory residential structure, one for single family dwelling addition, and one for a commercial building (4) personal property aid for 2023 (5) letter from Winnebago County Health department confirms first case of Monkey pox (6) Bonduel EMS monthly report for June and July. Clerk Przybylski also reported on the August Partisan Primary results.

Reports from Town Officers: Supervisor Przybylski Road Maintenance road name signs are in and Austin will be installing, will be filling pot holes this month on Green Valley, Elm, West Deer, and Park Streets. Cross culvert ends on Deer Drive needs to be repacked: talked to Matt Zierden and he will check the culvert out. Supervisor Przybylski supervisor report (1) received a call from Zachary Peters about the road in front of his house affecting his basement wall, Church Drive was paved in 1994 (2) received a call about the speed limit in Zachow, it is 30 mph could it be changed to 25 mph like in Krakow (3) received several calls about the changing the speed limit to 45 mph on Middle Drive from County C to Highway 32 and Green Valley Road from Highway 160 to Town Line Road because of more people walking and bicycling with kids (4) attended a zoom meeting by National Association of Towns and Townships about applying for and writing grants (5) natural gas line will be installed in the hamlet of Angelica in the middle of October (6) talked to Karl Krueger from GEI Consultants about a core sample on Lake Sandia Drive. Price is \$500 for one hour. Mr. Krueger will do a visual check on September 13 for no charge.

Supervisor Van Asten (1) reported about a pot hole on Park Street (2) installed a fire number on Carroll Road (3) did the water test at Krakow Park (4) stop sign on Park & Main Streets needs to be replaced.

Town Chairman: Chairperson Kucksdorf talked to Luke Krueger on August 31 and he will clean up the metal, and said the property is sold and will close at the end of September. New owner will be putting up new garage. Matt Zierden and I went over the proposed roads Supervisor Przybylski suggested last month. Matt gave estimates for proposed roads. Nichols bridge barrier will cost \$1300 to repair and county was not responsible for the damage. NEW Rescue is working on the upcoming budget. With the increases in gas, insurance, utilities, the increased cost will be 18.13 per capita. Next meeting will be September 29, 2022. Shawano County hazard meeting was finalized on August 24. The state needs to approve the plan, then FEMA needs to approve the plan, and then the town needs to approve. The plan does not give the town any money, but can apply for funds in the future.

Shawano County Board Supervisor ~ District 11: James Przybylski reported that there was no county meeting last month and solid waste board is working on landfill closure cost and the town's responsibility of costs.

Public Comments: Susan Pomprowitz talked about snow plowing in Krakow. Snow plow trucks come later than they did in the past. James Mills talked about people walking on Green Valley Road between Nichols and Cuba Drive.

Matters for Discussion and Possible Action by Town Board in Open Session

- a. Grant Bystol talked about snow plowing town roads. Supervisor Van Asten and Supervisor Przybylski said the town received complaints about the size and amount of sand in the hamlet of Krakow. The County uses sand/salt mixture of 5% salt and 95% sand. Sand is screened to 8mm in size. It costs \$95.87/ton for salt compared to \$18.40/ton for sand. Supervisor Przybylski talked about the amount of sand put on County Road C building up the shoulder and water is standing on roadway. Starting December 1 there is a 24 hour staff for winter plowing. Shawano County plows roads for 13 towns out of 25. Cost is \$117/hour for man and equipment. Takes six hours one round to clean roads in Angelica. Brine is used on county and highway roads, it works faster but also use salt for staying power. Grant talked about culverts ends are best for safety and the county requires then for county roads. Supervisor Przybylski asked about the construction on Deer Drive and if the county found any issues with soft spots under the road toward Highway 32. Grant said there were not soft spots just a silty soil and breaker was added under the road. Supervisor Przybylski asked about that when the county does the bridge inspections if the board could come along and be aware of what to look for. Grant Bystol talked about the 123 bridges the county inspects and who does the inspection of the bridges over 20'. Brush cutting is \$161/hour for man and equipment. All rates set by Wisconsin Department of Transportation. Grant Bystol also talked about the roads the County is working on. County Road E (from County F to 117) should be paved in two weeks. Bridge on County HHH is being replaced, bridge will be two feet two inches higher. County will also be doing concrete repairs on Highway 29 between Bonduel and Shawano, county received \$150,000 from state to do this repair.
- b. Discussion took place on the garbage contract with Harter's and day of pickup will change from Thursday to Wednesday. Clerk Przybylski did hear back from another garbage company. Town will see what there contract is and take the matter up next month.
- c. Town resident did not make it to meeting, so Town will take matter up next month.
